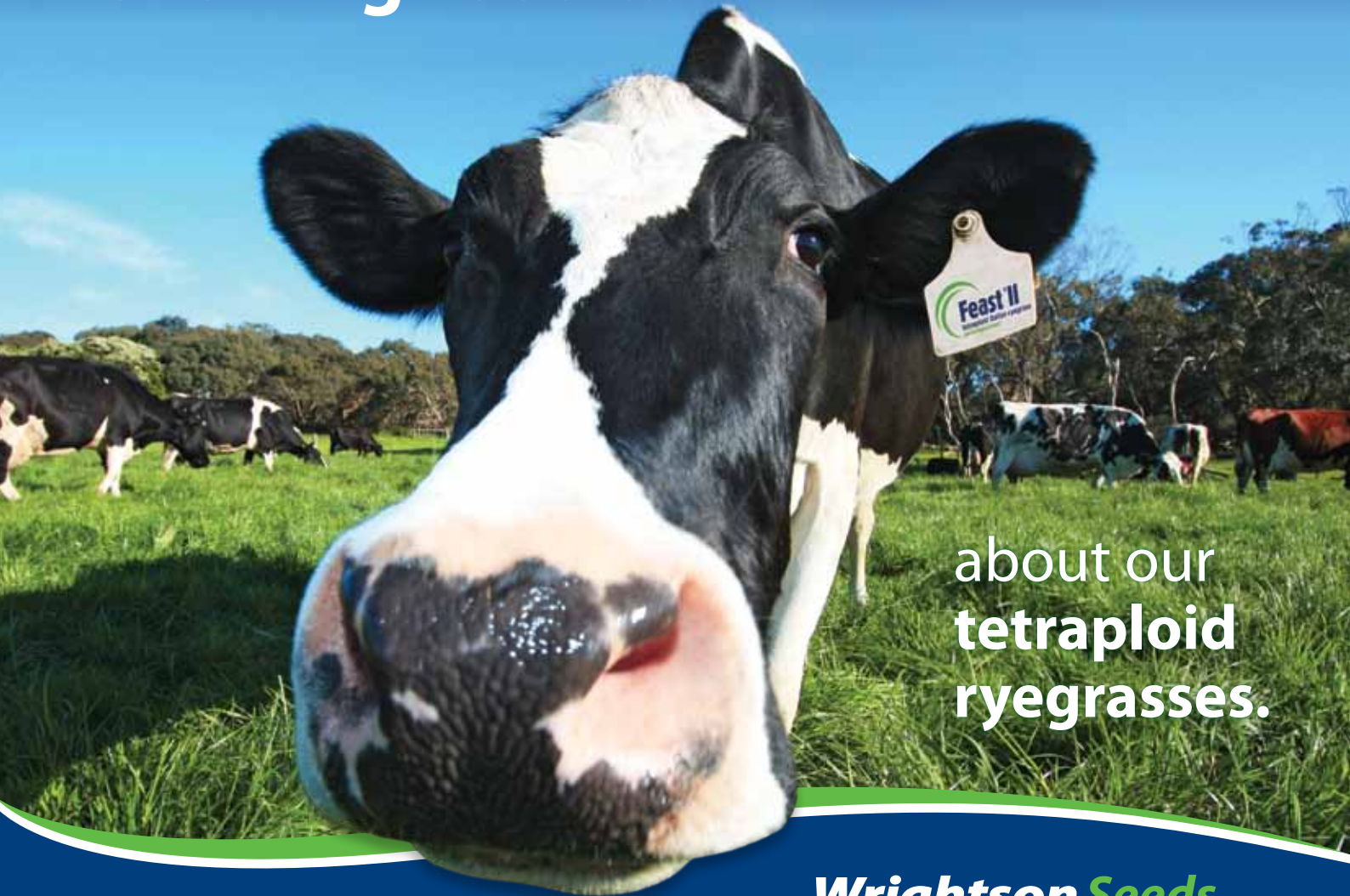

Reliable tetraploid annual ryegrass that:

- is easily established by oversowing
- has exceptional winter and early spring growth rates
- consistently produces high winter-early spring yields
- is a good value, robust utility annual ryegrass

Sungrazer T is a more reliable grazing option than Tetila which may vary significantly in performance. Sungrazer T completes its lifecycle early, producing maximum feed through winter and early spring.

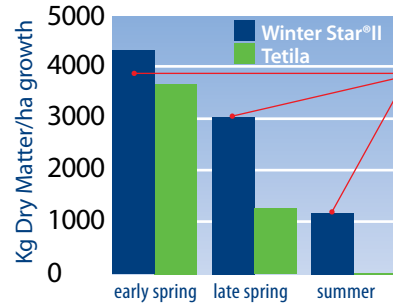
Elite tetraploid annual ryegrass that:

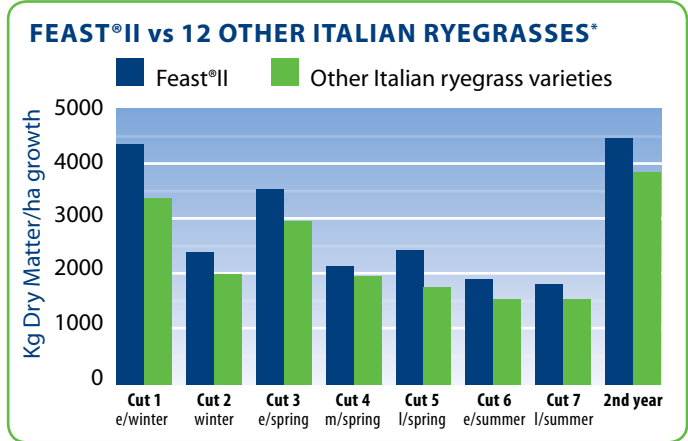


Tetraploid italian ryegrass that may persist for 2 years with high yields and good summer-autumn quality.

Elite tetraploid italian ryegrass that:

- establishes easily by oversowing
- has high all-season growth rates
- holds quality well through summer and autumn
- offers summer-autumn grazing depending upon rainfall
- persists, enabling quick regrowth from summer and autumn showers

Feast®II combines excellent winter-early spring grazing or silage making with good quality summer to second autumn grazing.

Banquet[®] II tetraploid long rotation ryegrass can have winter growth rates of up to 60 kgDM/ha/day – three times those of some older varieties.

Dependable long-term ryegrass that:

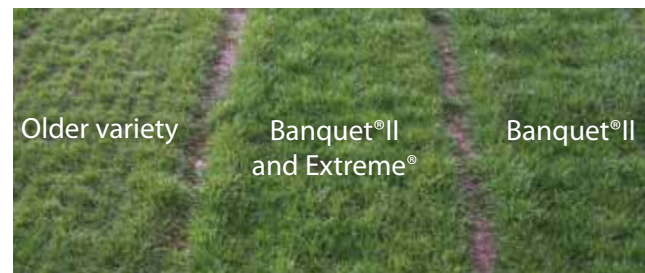
- has excellent late season quality (late maturing)
- tolerates many pasture pests providing excellent persistence
- has minimal dormancy and springs into production following rain

Banquet[®] II has minimal winter dormancy and can produce up to three times the dry matter of older perennial ryegrasses at the first grazing after a late break.

Banquet[®] II contains Endo5 endophyte, giving improved animal production and health compared with standard (wild) endophyte. Endo5 produces low levels of the compound ergovaline, giving improved protection against insect pests compared with AR1 endophyte. Like AR1, Endo5 does not produce lolitrem B, the main agent causing ryegrass staggers. To minimise ergovaline intake, and therefore maintain best animal production and health, avoid close grazing of fresh regrowth under hot late summer/early autumn conditions.

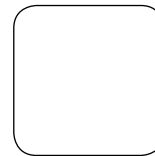
